1. Club Updates:

- All attending coaches gave brief reviews of their clubs' summer activities

2. ADC Update & National Rules (Gordie):

- National Rules will be included in the QRS
- ADC group revised and distributed the 2015 National Equipment Rules
- Rule 2.1.3 regarding FIS races in USA limiting competitors with more than 120 national points – ACTION: Gordie to discuss ramifications for 1st year FIS athletes at the Super Series
- Rule 2.2 regarding International Children's races ACTION: Gordie will express BCA support
 of WMSC Europe project for U16's to continue to gain international support of Whistler Cup
- Rule 4.2 regarding NCAA BC athletes ACTION: Gordie to discuss with ADC group some flexibility in this rule
- Rule 5.0 regarding number of race starts, BC coaches feel the ACA maximum race start chart should be by age category, not by individual YOB **ACTION**: Martin Tichy will present to Gordie a simplified race start chart; **ACTION**: Gordie to present this chart to ADC group
- Re FIS equipment rules and CWG, the SG radius rule of 30 meters for ladies and men will be problematic – ACTION: Gordie to discuss with ADC group adopting the Can Am rules for CWG, as opposed to the FIS rules, which would have no minimum radius for SG

3. BC Open Series – Equipment Rules, Awards, Format (Gordie):

- BC Teck Open Series is new this year for U16 to U99
- 8 races consisting of 2 SG, 3 GS and 3 SL
- Parsons will include 2 DH races (will not count toward PRS totals)
- Seeding will be from National Points ACTION Gordie will put this in the QRS
- Events to be hosted by Sun Peaks, Red Mountain and Whistler
- Speed Camp will precede Whistler Open Series
- Equipment rules will follow BC Alpine rules as stated in QRS ACTION: Gordie to advise ACA that the Parsons will host a pre-event speed camp

4. FIS Super Series – Events, Series Points (Gordie):

- Will host 3 events Panorama, Kimberley & Schweitzer
- Series will include 2DH, 6SG, 8 GS, 7SL

6. CWG 2015 Prince George - Alpine, Ski Cross Qualifiers (Gordie/Justine):

- CWG Technical Package was reviewed 7 men and 7 ladies from BC will compete in alpine and ski cross events
- 5 men and 5 ladies will qualify at alpine events
- 2 additional men and 2 additional ladies will qualify at ski cross events
- 2 coaches and 1 ski tech will accompany the team
- Gordie reviewed the BC Alpine long list of athletes to ensure nobody was missed
- Selection will be determined by the PRS through the first 2 events of the Teck Open Series (Sun Peaks and Rossland)
- Ski Cross qualifiers will be determined at an independent ski cross venue

7. CWG Coach Positions, Appointments (Gordie/Justine):

- Coaches reviewed the coaching team which must include one female CSCF High Performance coach (L3)
- It was agreed Justine Parent would take that role, in addition to Jeff MacLennan and Wade Christie (as ski technician)

- Schedule: 2 SG, 1 GS, 1 SL the first SG will be the championship event
- Schedule noted in agenda book changed day 3 is men GS and women SL day 4 is men SL and women GS

9. BC Ski Team Summer Recap, Training Group & Selection (Andrew/Gordie):

- BC Alpine staff reviewed the 2014-15 selection guidelines as the selection criteria has been altered from 2013-14
- The priority will continue to national rank by age and younger, but will also include head-tohead results, injury status and BC Ski Team staff discretion

- Andrew discussed the need for BCA to work toward normative fitness data for clubs with the goal of obtaining usable data to improve fitness programs

As a result of the enormous success of the Whistler Cup U14 Festival we are increasingly challenged to accommodate all entry requests. We are committed to maintaining the quality of this international race and to ensuring the equity, fairness and integrity of the entry process. Consequently, we propose the following points of clarity regarding race entries for the Whistler Cup U14 festival.

International Entries

The ROC will reserve 30 spots per gender for International racers which should be confirmed by February 15. On March 01, any unclaimed international spots will be released. After this date international entries are no longer guaranteed a spot.

In the spirit of Whistler Cup we endeavor to include as many international racers as we can. However, the ROC is concerned that racers of dual nationality, who reside and race in Canada, have used nationality of their non-residential country to ensure entry into the Whistler Cup. We believe this action threatens to compromise the quality and integrity of this prestigious international competition. Consequently, competitors are expected to race for their country of residence and we would ask that racers who are registered with a PSO in Canada – and reside in Canada – follow the same entry procedures of their fellow Canadian citizens. In other words, international entries for competitors who reside in Canada and have ACA national points must be entered with their local team and not as international racers.

Provincial Entries

Note that the term "Provincial Teams" refers to racers registered in the provinces of Canada, the host country, and not any other Provinces. (No Australian Provinces)

The Roc will reserve 30 spots per gender for Provincial teams which should be confirmed by January 31st.













Each Canadian Province will be permitted to send one team consisting of 3 boys and 3 girls. If Canadian Provinces have not registered/confirmed a team by this date, their spot will become available to club teams on February 1st and entry will no longer be guaranteed.

Any Canadian Provinces wishing to enter a second team will be considered along with club teams and must reserve their spots by January 1st.

Clubs

Club teams must reserve not later than January 15. Entry opens December 1st. Clubs and second Provincial teams are allocated on a first come, first served basis, although priority will be given to second Provincial teams over clubs. Please note that depending on the field entered by International and Canadian Provincial teams we cannot guarantee a place to any individual clubs. No default quota will be allocated to BC clubs.

Eligibility

We would like to suggest that ONLY the second year U14 enter the Whistler Cup Festival. We believe in giving a chance to race the Whistler Cup to everybody. A great first year will still be a fantastic second year skier and probably will make it to U16. Maybe this is the chance for the middle of the pack to get to shine. Also some families, racers benchmark Whistler Cup as THE race. Maybe it is a little early for a 12 year old to have achieved this already?

As with the U14s, the ROC is concerned that some racers of dual nationality – who are registered Canadian racers and reside in Canada - have taken advantage of their dual citizenship to ensure entry into the Whistler Cup when they might not otherwise have qualified. One result is that weaker racers have been seeded inappropriately. Including a weak racer in the top seed is not sportsmanlike, and tends to compromise the quality and integrity of the race. On occasion this has also compromised safety on course, particularly in races with a fixed interval.

To maintain the integrity of Whistler Cup we ask that all racers of dual nationality represent their country of residence and not use their second nationality to gain entry into a race and a seeding position that is not in keeping with their skills and ability level. Please be aware that the jury will take appropriate steps to ensure the safety of the competitors and this may include a decision to change the start order. Such decisions will be announced at the Team Captains Meeting and any actions that are considered unsportsmanlike are subject to sanctioning by the Jury.

The following FIS rules support this action:

- 204.1.1 A National Ski Association shall not support or recognise within its structure, nor shall it
 issue a licence to participate in FIS or national races to any competitor who has conducted himself in
 an improper or unsportsmanlike manner.
- 205.5 Competitors must behave in a correct and sportsmanlike manner towards members of the Organising Committee, volunteers, officials and the public.
- 601.4.6.1 Duties of the jury: Changing the start order after consideration of course conditions and in extraordinary conditions.

Also may we suggest to use the Whistler Cup as an opportunity for Canadians to run a U14 and U16 Nationals? We would then follow la Scara's model, whereas your best will stay to compete in the Whistler Cup enhancing the level of racing.

FIS Equipment Rules

Athletes competing in FIS events must compete on equipment that respects FIS rules. This includes International Children races. Please note the new helmet rule for the FIS: Please note for 2014/15 and onwards the FIS helmet rule for GS/SG/DH is in effect for ALL FIS level races including World Cup and Continental Cup racing. The FIS equipment rules can be found at the following <a href="https://link.com/l

National Head Protection Rule -U16 & Younger

Ski helmets specific to alpine skiing are mandatory and must be in accordance with FIS compliant rules. Only helmets are permitted whose shell and padding cover the head and ears. The National Ski Associations are advised to provide their teams only with crash helmets which satisfy the minimum requirements and which have been certified by recognized institutes. Certain helmets must show a smooth top surface for safety reasons.

2. Out of Country Race Entries and Eligibility

Please note this policy does not include racing in the United States. Racing in the United States is allowable as long as all entries flow through and are approved by the Provincial Sport Organization and the National Sport Organization.

The policy in place is meant to support a strong domestic development system that supports the principles of our Long Term Skier Development model.

2.1 FIS Races in the US

- 2.1.1 As a country group (FIS Rules of the Points 9.1.6), the USA and Canada are allowed to race up to 30 competitors in the other countries' FIS competitions. There are some competitions where the USA and Canada have asked for and been granted an exception to the country group of 30 men and 30 women where they can fill the total to 140 respecting other nations quotas.
- 2.1.2 The two nations have a working agreement to limit the number of competitors to 15 in each other's FIS competitions unless the nations have come to prior agreement to expand beyond
- 2.1.3 As a minimum standard to be considered for qualification to race across the border, athletes should have at least 120 points or better in one of the disciplines being contested in any series. Entry for athletes with points greater than 120 is at the PSO discretion.
- 2.1.4 Any exceptions or extensions to 2.1.2 or 2.1.3 is at the discretion of the two national governing bodies. A formal written request must be made prior to the race. In Canada these requests must come from the PSOs to the NSO.
- 2.1.5 Races entries need to be submitted to the National Office from the PSO no later than 7 days prior to the first team captains race.
- 2.1.6 Any changes need to be communicated to the National Office and the ROC at least 24 hours prior to the first team captains meeting. Failure to provide adequate notice can result in a monetary sanction fee to the coach equivalent to the race entry fee. This sanction is at the discretion of the National Office

2.2 FIS Races outside of North America

- 2.2.1 Athletes who are not part of the Canadian Alpine Ski Team wishing to be considered to enter competitions outside of North America should have less than 60.0 FIS Points or less in at least one discipline.
 - 2.2.1.1 ACA will consider exemption request to rule 2.1.1 for athletes who can clearly demonstrate that they are outside of North America for reasons other than ski racing and who wish to participate in ski races for recreational reasons. Exemption to this rule is at the discretion of the PSO.
- 2.2.2 Europa Cup races are reserved for CAST athletes or CAST coaching staff invitees.
- 2.2.3 All Non-North American entries must be submitted through the PSO who then send them to ACA. Direct contact with the ROCs are prohibited.

- 2.2.4 Out of country quota is always managed by ACA. CAST athletes have priority and CAST entries are accepted until 24 hours prior to a race. All other entries need to be submitted to Alpine Canada 2 weeks prior to the first team captains meeting. Alpine Canada reserves the right to deny any late entries.
- 2.2.5 Canadian athletes without valid permission from ACA who enter, or attempt to enter a race outside of North America are subject to disciplinary actions, which may include revocation of ACA membership and no possibilities to enter FIS races for a period of one year.
- 2.2.6 All racers with a Canadian FIS card residing full time outside of North America that do not qualify on the above criteria will NOT be granted entrance into FIS races outside of North America.
- 2.3 International Children (Kinder) Races: Official entries for International Children Races must be made through ACA.

3. Nor-Am Competition Eligibility

All athletes with a valid FIS license are eligible to compete in NorAm competitions without any restrictions related to their points or performance at other FIS races.

4. Canadians at U.S. Academies, College and Universities

- 4.1 Provinces are requested to submit to the Manager, Membership Services at the National Office, no later than October 15 of each year, a list of any athletes from their member clubs who are competing for a US Academy Program or US College or University Team. The following information is required: FIS Number, athlete name, Academy/College/University name, mailing address, and Coach responsible. Those athletes compete under quotas for their respective province. Entries must flow from their respective PSO to the National Office. ACA will not accept any entries directly from college coaches.
- 4.2 Academy/University CAN FIS card holder race entry procedure: Ex-PST and Ex CAST athletes must participate in 4 FIS starts in CAN during a 2 year period. The above rule applies to all athletes wishing to be considered for selection for World U Games.

5. Number of Race Starts

The number of starts for first year eligibility FIS athletes is set by the FIS (ICR rule # 607.3). In the case where an athlete exceeds this number, the races that are in excess will not be counted for points. The number of starts an athlete has done is indicated on the FIS list.

The same principle is to apply to nationally carded athletes in Canada. The number of starts per age category is set by the AIM document, and is recorded on the national points list. Any athlete, who exceeds this number of starts, will not have those results count.

6. FIS Downhill Eligibility

The eligibility to compete in FIS downhill competitions for Canadian athletes is restricted to FIS level athletes who have successfully completed at least one speed camp sanctioned by ACA or having gone through an equivalent progression of downhill elements training by a recognized facilitator sanctioned by ACA or the PSO.

7. FIS-UNI Races

7.1. Eligibility

- 7.1.2 Age: Participation in FIS-UNI (University) competitions is restricted to student athletes who are at least 17 years old and less than 28 years old at the time of the competition.
- 7.1.3 Program requirement: Student-athlete must be registered for and pursuing a full program of study leading towards a degree or diploma at a post-secondary institution. Post-secondary institutions include community colleges, professional schools, technical schools, C.E.G.E.P., and universities, in Canada or outside of Canada.
- 7.1.4 Course load requirement: Student-athlete must be enrolled in a minimum of three (3) courses (minimum 9 credit hours or equivalent) in the term in which they are competing in a FIS-UNI competition.
- 7.1.5 Academic standing: Student-Athlete must be considered in good standing by their institution by having successfully completed a minimum of three full courses, or six half courses, or eighteen semester hours during the academic year.

The only exception to this rule is for CEGEP student-athlete who are eligible to compete as long as they are recognized as being in good standing and full-time student by their CEGEP.

- 7.1.6 Proof of eligibility: All student-athletes must be listed on the AUC document on file at the National Office in order to be eligible to race. It is the PSO's responsibility to ensure lists are accurate prior to the beginning of each season.
- 7.1.7 Maximum years: An athlete shall be allowed to participate in FIS-UNI competitions for five (5) academic years.
- 7.1.8 The entry must include the name of the coach travelling with the athlete to the race, in order for the race entry to be eligible for submission.

7.2 Quotas

- 7.2.1 In all alpine FIS-UNI races the maximum number of participants is 140. For all nations the quota is 20 participants per gender and discipline with 4 spots eligible for non-collegiate athletes. The organizing country may fill to the maximum of 140 competitors with his own competitors.
- 7.2.2 Host-nation unused quotas: If the maximum number of participants (140 women or men) is not reached, the start list cannot be filled with non student-athletes.

7.3 Race Organizing Committee Responsibilities for CAN UNI FIS races

- 7.3.1 Entries: ROC's are responsible for the management of entries according to the above eligibility criteria. All Canadian entries will be managed inter-provincially.
- 7.3.2 PSO's are to submit team numbers and athlete information (name & points profile) 2 weeks prior to first Team Captains meeting as per host PSO policy. Please entry the coach attending the race is clearly identified.
- 7.3.3 PSO must communicate and receive confirmation of any additions/deletions to the original entry 5 days prior to first Team Captains meeting with the host Race Organizing Committee (ROC)
- 7.3.4 It is the host ROC/PSO's responsibility to communicate any changes to the waitlist to the affected PSO.
- 7.3.5 All foreign entries must be approved through the National Office. Please forward any foreign entries to the Manager, Membership Services for approval.
- 7.3.6 Race Notice: All race notices must include the following disclaimers:

Eligibility: FIS and ACA rules apply. FIS UNI quota & eligibility criteria apply for all entries.
